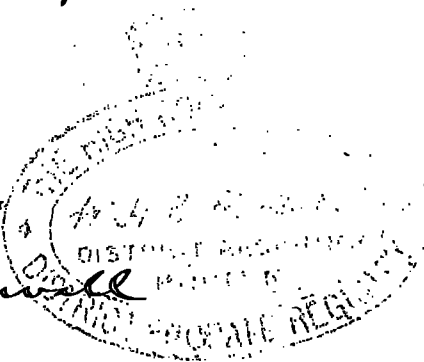

payment of my debts funeral and testamentary
expenses, and the provision of a Headstone to be
placed over my Grave in the Gunwalloe Churchyard
I give devise and bequeath all the rest residue and
remainder of my property of whatsoever sort or kind
and wheresoever the same may be at the time of my
decease unto my Nephew Thomas George of Nanfan
in the said parish of Cury I nominate and appoint
my said Nephew Thomas George Sole Executor of this
my Will In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand to this my Will this Eighteenth day of June
One thousand nine hundred and twelve.
