I EDWARD LUGG of 97 Marlborough Road, Upper Holloway, in the County of London Blacksmith hereby revoke all former Wills and testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last Will - I appoint William Joseph Robbins of 218 Strand in the County of London & Wilson Lugg my son of 51 Duncombe Road Hornsey Rise EXECUTORS of this my Will and after payment of my debts funeral and testamentary expenses I give devise & bequeath to my Daughter Lydia Maud Lugg my leasehold house situate at Gunwalloe Helston in the County of Cornwall known as "new Cottage" together with its entire contents and the remainder of my interest in property situate at Gunwalloe aforesaid I give in equal shares to my four sons I give to my sons Edward & Thomas Freeman Lugg in equal shares my share of the business (carried on by myself & my Brother William Lugg) provided that they pay to their Sister Lydia Maud Lugg a sum of ten shillings a week for the twelve months following my death All Book debts to date of my death will go to form part of my estate To Edward Lydia Maud Thomas Freeman & Wilson Lugg I give in equal shares my private residence No 97 Marlborough Road aforesaid subject to the mortgage of £275 now £250 I give to my Daughter Lydia Maud Lugg the contents of my private residence to distribute in accordance with my wishes which will be made known to her on my death All the residue of my estate including my late daughter's (Annie Eleanor Lugg) share of the funds under my Marriage Settlement I give to my surviving children in equal shares IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 14th day of September One thousand nine
